CHROMEBOOK INITIATIVE



What is the Chromebook Initiative?

- All 9th grade students will be given a Chromebook to use for the school year.
- Students can take devices to and from school daily.
- Each year, we will add a grade of students who will be given a Chromebook.



Overview of Student Responsibilities

General Care	Acceptable Use
<p>Keep your battery charged.</p> <p>Do not lend your Chromebook to anyone.</p> <p>Know where your Chromebook is at all times.</p> <p>Keep your Chromebook Secure.</p> <p>Keep your Chromebook Safe.</p> <p>Report any issues with your Chromebook immediately to the high school library.</p>	<p>Only school-appropriate content is acceptable on the device.</p> <p>You may use your Chromebook at home with your home's wireless access.</p> <p>Apps, extensions, and systems installed by the district should not be removed or tampered with.</p> <p>Follow the rules and procedures in the handbook.</p> <p>Return your device in June for maintenance.</p>



Logistics

- Parent/Guardians and students must sign all forms before receiving their Chromebook.
- Students are responsible for securing their Chromebook, charging it daily, and bringing it to class ready to use.
- Students may not remove their Chromebook from its case. They may, however, personalize their case with stickers that are appropriate for school.
- Students must secure their Chromebooks in their lockers before going to extracurricular activities and athletics.



Damage, Loss, Theft

- All damages, loss and theft should be reported to the high school library.
- Low cost insurance is available for parents.
- Loaners will be provided as available.
- If lost/stolen, the student and parent/guardian should report the loss/theft to the grade level assistant principal immediately.
- All district-owned devices can be located by the district using software that is pre-installed.
- Students are still responsible for all course work.



Insurance Information

- The district has chosen Worth Ave Group to provide additional Chromebook Insurance for student devices. This insurance covers unlimited incidents of:



Theft, Burglary & Robbery



Power Surge



Fire & Flood & Natural Disasters



Vandalism

- The cost for the insurance is \$12.00/device for the school year.

Restrictions

- Students cannot use their own device at school. School-issued devices are the only devices permitted to be used.
- Students may only use their Chromebooks for school appropriate uses.
- Students should not lend their Chromebook to other students as they are responsible for it.
- School based web filtering is installed on the Chromebook and will filter websites on home wireless networks. However, guardians should actively monitor their child's usage.
