Dear Kindergarten Families,

The following is a list of supplies that your student will need for Kindergarten.

- \* 1. 1 composition (marble) notebooks (any color)
2. 4 oz. Bottle of Elmer's school glue or glue-all (orange top). Please only get Elmer's as other brands tend to clog easily. Also, please do not buy the "no-run" glue as it is very difficult to use.
3. 6 jumbo glue sticks (at least .70 oz) preferably Elmer's or UHU brand
- \* 4. A good quality pair of scissors. We recommend Fiskars for Kids.
5. 2 boxes of regular (wide) tip markers in basic colors
6. 1 box of 24 Crayola crayons
7. 1 package of Post-Its (your choice as to size and color)
8. 1 package of 3x5 index cards (lined or unlined - any color or white)
- \* 9. 1 sturdy folder with 2 bottom pockets for transporting papers and notes
- \* 10. 1 sturdy plastic folder with 3 prongs and bottom pockets
11. 2 regular dry erase markers (any color). We recommend Expo brand, as they last the longest.
12. 2 skinny dry erase markers (any color). We recommend Expo brand, as they last the longest.
- \* 13. 1 green Grade 1 composition notebook (these can be found at Staples or any teacher store)
14. 4 boxes of baby wipes
15. 1 box of Ziploc bags: Please follow the size chart below
  - If your child's last name begins with A-M = gallon size
  - If your child's last name begins with N-Z = snack size
16. 1 box of tissues
- \* 17. 1 old clean sock
- \* 18. 1 large backpack to carry home papers and projects. Please be sure that it is large enough to fit a folder inside. Please do not purchase backpacks with wheels, as they are not necessary in Kindergarten and take up too much space.
- \* 19. A pullover smock or large t-shirt. This should cover to the knees. Please do not use shirts with buttons as they are difficult for the children to manage on their own.
- \* 20. A change of clothes in case of accidents or spills. Please put these in a large Ziploc bag so that they don't get dirty in your child's cubby.

**\*\*Please only label those numbered items that have an asterisk (\*) with your child's name. The rest of the supplies will become classroom community supplies. Thank you for your cooperation!**

**\*\*Please be advised that individual teachers may ask for additional supplies.\*\***

# First Grade Supply List

In order to make it easier on the children we ask that you send in the supplies a little at a time.

On the first day of school please make sure your child has the following supplies:

- 1 box of Crayola crayons (24 count)
- 1 box of WIDE Crayola markers (classic colors)
- 1 box of THIN Crayola markers (classic colors)
- 12 Sharpened pencils
- 1 pair of scissors (Fiskas work best)
- 1 4oz Elmers WHITE GLUE with ORANGE top
- 2 glue sticks (try to get the large size)
- 1 BOTTOM POCKET folder
- 1 PLASTIC BOTTOM POCKET FOLDER WITH 3 PRONGS
- 2 plastic supply boxes that will fit inside desk (approx 5 x 8)
- 3 Black and White composition notebooks (WIDE RULED)
- 1 smock (oversized T-shirt, no buttons) and a ziplock bag that the smock will fit in

Please send in the rest of the supplies by the end of the week:

- 3 boxes of Crayola crayons (24 count)
- 1 box of WIDE Crayola markers (classic colors)
- 1 box of THIN Crayola markers (classic colors)
- 1 WHITE HARD COVER  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch binder with view front
- 10 sheet protectors
- 2 highlighters (any color)
- 8 glue sticks (try to get large size)
- 1 pack of 3 x 3 post-its
- 2 4oz Elmers WHITE GLUE with ORANGE top
- 1 3 x 5 INDEX CARD BOX (approx 3 x 5)
- 2 packages of WHITE index cards
- 2 DRY ERASE markers and 1 pair of OLD socks

The following is a list of supplies needed for third grade.

  - ⇒ 1 box thin tip
  - ⇒ 1 box regular tip
- ⇒ Scissors
- ⇒ 1 small bottle of Elmer's glue
- ⇒ 6 glue sticks
- ⇒ Ruler with centimeters and inches
- ⇒ 1 marble composition notebook
- ⇒ 5 plastic folders
  - ⇒ 1 red, 1 blue, 1 green, 1 yellow, 1 any color

- ⇒ 1 pack of 3 x 3 Post-It Notes

## Supply List

- 24 pencils-sharpened

- Eraser(optional)
- Hand held pencil sharpener(optional)
- 1 package of 3 x 5 index cards
- Earbuds (to be used in the computer lab)
